

## Job description



**Job title:** *Environmental Manager*

**Report To:** **Environment Director/Commercial Director**

**Job Location:** **Taipei**

### **General :**

- The role will be supporting the improvement of the recycling beverage carton's business by mapping and understanding the different players and support value creation across the chain.
- The role will work with local authorities with an aim to raise recycling rate while reducing cost for the company. He/she should strive to lobby local authorities and improve the current fee scheme.
- The role will be developing and consolidating local environmental contents across the value chain which Tetra Pak is in (packaging, processing and food industry), and supporting external and internal communication with environmental message delivery.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Support Tetra Pak in Taiwan to develop mapping of carton's recycling value chain, and look for strategies to enhance expansion of carton recycling with reduced cost from Tetra Pak.
- Identify KEY Performance Indicators for those value chain, and monitor the progress of those KPI over time, and help all the stakeholders to strengthen value chain.
- Work closely with local authorities, non-government organization, waste management companies and other stakeholders to raise recycling rate, improve the current fee scheme while reducing cost for the company.
- Monitor competition's recycling activities and Environment positioning to prepare adequate counter argument if necessary.
- Cooperate with carton recyclers and collectors to manage projects of capacity expansion and technology improvement.
- Support Tetra Pak in Taiwan to produce and justify investment/expense plans when needed by understand and qualify all the business plans.

- Monitor carbon discussion progress in Taiwan, and if necessary join the discussion with authorities/NGO to secure sound pointing of beverage carton in carbon discussion.
- Support marketing company in Taiwan to consolidate and deliver environment related messages.
