Tetra Pak Presents Enviro Board at Ban Lae Suan Fair 2023, Highlighting New Materials Made out of Recycled UHT Cartons



Bangkok (March 23, 2023) - Tetra Pak, a world-leading processing and packaging solutions company, led by Mr. Patinya Silsupadol, Head of Sustainability Tetra Pak (Thailand) Limited, presented Enviro Board — a wood substitute material made of recycled UHT carton packaging. Enviro Board will be used for constructing decorations at Ban Lae Suan Fair 2023 held during the week of Global Recycling Day to highlight the role of recycling in creating new useful materials.

At the event, visitors will be able to walk around the Room Showcase zone to see various recycling products, and also look at the highlight of the event, the entrance arch, which is constructed from materials made out of recycled beverage cartons under the concept “From Waste to Resource”. During the fair this entrance arch will serve as a waste collection point, where attendees can drop waste materials including discarded UHT cartons for further recycling. The archway was also designed with a multi-purpose functionality in mind. After the fair it will be transformed into a playground and will be donated to Ban Mai Khao school in Phuket province. This donation was made possible by the CSR collaboration project between Amarin Printing and Publishing Public Company Limited and Tetra Pak (Thailand) Limited.
